April 12th 2021

City Council met in a regular session at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Rubendall presiding.

Council members present: E. Wolff, Moore, Rover, Hannan, D. Wolff (arrived late).

Motion Rover seconded Hannan to approve the agenda all ayes' motion passed.

Motion Moore seconded E. Wolff to approve the March minutes all ayes' motion carried.

Motion Rover seconded Moore to approve the treasure's report bank statement all ayes' motion carried.

In new business:

Mayor and council members received 2 resumes for the city clerk position, after interviewing both Motion was made by Moore seconded E. Wolff to hire Kim McLeish for the position with training wage of \$15.00 per hour and gross salary of \$625 a month starting May 1, 2021 all ayes motion carried.

Motion E. Wolff seconded Moore to change city hall hours to Monday and Tuesday 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. all ayes motion carried.

Motion Hannan seconded Rover to adopt Resolution#2012-4 Adaption of Investment Policy with a roll call vote Rover; aye Hannan; aye E. Wolff; aye Moore; aye Absent D. Wolff.

Motion Hannan seconded Moore to have Alliant Energy put up a flood light on the West side of the road on Cass Street South across from city property (220 S. Cass) for security reason's when the library gets the story boards put up all aye's motion carried.

LaTasha Wolff was present on behalf of the Community Club asking for a donation Westgate Days, council and Mayor had slight discussion motion was made by Moore seconded Rover, Hannan abstained from vote all others aye motion carried.

Motion Moore seconded Hannan to approve the renewal of Bank Bar and Grill liquor license, pending dram shop approval, all ayes motion carried.

In old business:

S. Hannan was present on behalf of the Community Club told council and Mayor that the Vendor Show was a big success the Community Club raised so far toward the renovation/restoration of the Opera House \$ 2,614 towards the goal of \$5,000. Motion D. Wolff seconded Rover to approve fire works on August 14th at dusk for Westgate Days all ayes motion carried.

City clerk will contact Cushion Plumbing and Heating concerning water issues at the Fire Station and Opera House, clerk will also contact city attorney with question about changing city hall hours to Monday and Tuesday 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. starting May 1 2021 and property on Olive Street, city clerk will contact City insurance about fireworks for Westgate Days.

Mayor and Council members discussed Ash trees that need to be removed from city property at 220 Cass Street S.




